

Did Man Really Walk with Dinosaurs?

Main Points:

When working with a class, I advise setting up a point system. In a point system, students, on the first day of class, state what they would like to work toward. It would help if you thought about charging parents a fee for the class, and those fees go toward the kid's prizes for the top three who earn the most points, or you can use this as a ministry opportunity and absorb the costs. An idea of a reward prize could be a book of interest in the subjects you are learning together to start their library with a gift card.

Earning points is essential for two reasons. First, I have seen kids start to take notes and memorize facts while earning points, and second, they learn to be goal oriented.

After each video, I questioned them about what they had learned. You could also have a review at the beginning of class of what you have learned the previous day or days. Kids retain what they talk about repeatedly.

- Dinosaurs Artwork

 - What are the long-necked sauropod dinosaurs found on Richard Bells's tomb called now? **Bishop Bell's brass behemoths.**
 - A Roman Mosaic from 200AD depicts what? **Two long-necked sea dinosaurs that look like a Tanystropheus**
 - What is the dinosaur called in the Wupatki National Park? **Puff the magic dragon**
 - A petroglyph in Arizona's Havasupai Canyon shows what type of dinosaur? **A Edmontosaurus**

- In the jungles of Cambodia, the temple, Ta Prohm, depicts what dinosaur? **The Stegosaurus**
- Dinosaur Stonework
 - What stones shows dinosaurs living with man? **The Ica stones**
- What happens to evidence that contradicts evolution?
 - **Anomalies that go against evolution are what? Hidden or eliminated.**
 - **What was found in the jaw of a fossil? It was a spear. What happened to the archeologist who discovered it? They were forbidden to return to the site and asked to sign a form that they planted the information.**
 - **What do some believe needs to happen to make sure something is scientific? A peer review which will not happen if a discovery goes against the world view of evolution.**
