

# Are Dragons Alive Today?

## Main Points

When working with a class, I advise setting up a point system. In a point system, students, on the first day of class, state what they would like to work toward. It would help if you thought about charging parents a fee for the class, and those fees go toward the kid's prizes for the top three who earn the most points, or you can use this as a ministry opportunity and absorb the costs. An idea of a reward prize could be a book of interest in the subjects you are learning together to start their library with a gift card.

Earning points is essential for two reasons. First, I have seen kids start to take notes and memorize facts while earning points, and second, they learn to be goal oriented.

After each video, I questioned them about what they had learned. You could also have a review at the beginning of class of what you have learned the previous day or days. Kids retain what they talk about repeatedly.

- What was the name of the dinosaur in the book of Job? **Behemoth**
- What does God say to Job at the beginning of Job 40:15? **Behold now behemoth.** What does that mean? **Behemoth could be seen**
- Living Fossils
  - **Coelacanth Fish**
  - **Frill Shark**
  - **Mega Mouth Shark**
  - **Glass Sponge**
  - **Vampire Squid**
  - **Wollemi Pine**
  
- What percentage of the ocean has been explored? **5%**
- What continues to grow their whole life? **Reptiles**
- What dragon living right now grows 10 feet in length and their bite causes blood poisoning? **Comodo dragon**
- The Chinese Zodiac contains 12 animals, all are real including the? **Dragon**
- List the 5 reasons people don't see very many Dragons or dinosaurs today:
  - **Camera is not ready**
  - **Environment is different**
  - **People have killed them in the past**
  - **Unexplored areas in both land and sea**

- **Blindness factor – people forget that dragons and dinosaurs were large because of the pre-flood environment and how long they lived. We could be looking at some of the same animals today, but they are small**
